Shining lights a winner

DON'T stop puffing out those chests yet though, Canberra, because one of our very own artists has also won the ACT Architecture Award. Robert Foster has been awarded the Light in Architecture Prize for his glowing

feature sculpture *The Journey*, pictured. Positioned in the foyer of ActewAGL, the sculpture features 37 heat-moulded, tusk-like shapes that appear to push through the foyer's polished concrete floor. Thousands of LED lights are embedded in the design, changing colours to give the impression of budding shoots or fossilised bones. The sculpture has drawn many admiring looks from busy commuters in Bunda Street and is sure to be a talking point for years to come.
